**We** know Tom. It's **our** car. Tom knows **us**. It's **ours**.

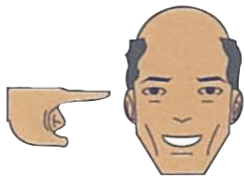

You know Tom. It's **your** car. Tom knows **you**. It's **yours**.

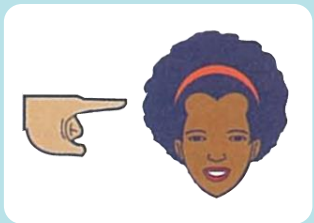


He knows Tom. It's **his** car. Tom knows **him**. It's **his**.

(= She gave her umbrella to him.)
